One of the First Practices Offering Dysport

DELRAY BEACH, Fla. – (June 24, 2009) – Dysport, a new simple, effective, non-surgical treatment that reduces and smoothes frown lines and wrinkles, has hit the market as a product comparable to Botox. Dr. Jacob D. Steiger of Steiger Facial Plastic Surgery in Delray Beach is one of the first South Florida physicians offering the newly FDA-approved product as he receives the first shipment available.

Supported by over a decade of clinical experience, Dysport (also known as Reloxin®), has been used in the past on patients who were resistant to Botox. The product has been said to spread more easily than Botox, covering a larger area and causing less bruising.

"In May, Dysport received FDA approval, which means that it is just as effective and safe as Botox," said Dr. Steiger, an accomplished, Ivy League-trained facial plastic surgeon. Dysport, an in-office injection procedure that can be performed with no downtime, is a neurotoxin, as is Botox. It improves the appearance by correcting dynamic facial wrinkles.

Dysport was developed in the United Kingdom in the early 1990s to successfully treat a number of neurological and ophthalmic conditions. Since that time, thousands of treatments have been safely and effectively performed.

In New Zealand, eye specialists and neurologists have used Dysport for over 12 years to treat nervous tics and muscle spasms of the face and neck. It was the first botulinum toxin Type A to be approved in that country for medical use.

"Safety and trust are the cornerstones of my practice," said Dr. Steiger. "I have thoroughly researched and investigated Dysport. With it, I'll continue to offer the best possible cosmetic care to my patients."
